Introduction

By 2027, ~23,000 large and medium-sized Australian businesses must report climate risks and impacts, in line with new government rules (ASIC media release September 2024). These new reporting requirements will impact finance roles, requiring new knowledge and skills to enable affected businesses to comply with the legislation.

Improving climate disclosures will support regulators in assessing and managing systemic risks to the financial system because of climate change and efforts taken to mitigate its effects. The new requirements will impact finance roles, necessitating an uplift for skills related to disclosures, reporting, data analysis, compliance, and transition planning. There are no current UoCs that cover this content.

Scope of the project

This project will develop new units of competency (UoCs) in the Financial Services (FNS) training package which will form one or more skill sets and be placed into existing qualifications as electives. The project will ensure the FNS training package is updated to comply with new financial sustainability reporting legislation.

The development process will adhere to the Training Package Organising Framework (TPOF), commencing 1 July 2025, ensuring that the new UoCs are consistent with the national approach to training product design, delivery, and compliance.

Outcomes:

New UoCs including knowledge and skills to enable businesses to comply with the new financial sustainability reporting legislation.

1. Initial Development

Website notification

September 2025

FSO will publish the project commencement, consultation process, and feedback options on the FSO Project website [Sustainable Finance Disclosures](#).

Establishment of Technical Committee

November 2025

FSO will send an email to key stakeholders seeking nominations to become a Sustainable Finance Disclosures Technical Committee member.

Following the expressions of interest (EOI), FSO will establish a Technical Committee to provide expert advice, based on evidence, across educational and expert and/or technical knowledge to assist the design and development of training products.

Membership of the Technical Committee will be proportional to the scope of the project.

Drafting Training Package Products Process

Drafting Training Products

November 2025 – May 2026

Scoping and review of training package products involves evaluating the new UOCs to ensure they meet industry and learner needs. This process includes:

- Identifying qualifications where the new UoCs will be placed as electives, deciding the most suitable template for UoCs, aligning with the new legislation, and incorporating feedback from stakeholders
- Scoping will include consultation with stakeholders to inform these decisions.

Drafting Consultation

Stakeholder engagement and collaboration will be open, proactive, inclusive, fair, and transparent across the Vocational Education and Training (VET) system and industry. Multiple mechanisms will be used to collect feedback to inform the development process including (but not limited to):

- Workshops
- Email Feedback
- Feedback Forms

These are designed to maximise participation opportunities and gather a comprehensive range of views and perspectives from stakeholders across Australia.

FSO and its contractors will engage with members from the consultation group and a wider network of stakeholders to acquire feedback through various communications channels. Release of the Draft Training Products

May 2026

The draft training products will be made available via FSOs project website page including consultation dates and options for providing feedback. The opening of consultation will be promoted through FSO newsletters, email alerts and social media, and reminders will be sent via the same mechanisms during the four-week consultation period.

3. Incorporating Feedback

Determine revisions

June 2026

Information collated from consultations will be analysed to identify potential actions, responses, and solutions. These actions, responses and solutions will be developed through regular facilitated processes including advice from the Technical Committee, and where necessary other subject matter experts. FSO will endeavour to incorporate feedback to ensure the final products reflect a shared RTO and industry view.

Technical Committee Statement

June 2026

The Technical Committee must review all training package products included in the submission. FSO receives confirmation statements from the Technical Committee that they have reviewed all the final draft training package products.

Additional consultation (if required)

July 2026

Additional consultation may be undertaken to manage diverse viewpoints or if significant changes have been made to the training product because of public and government consultation. Timeframes for any additional consultation will reflect the scope and complexity of the proposed changes.

Additional consultation process will be in line with [Undertake public and government consultations](#).

Provide justification

July - August 2026

Justification will be provided where consultation feedback is not implemented or broad consensus from stakeholders can not be reached, along with reasons why issues cannot be resolved. Any impact on learners and employment outcomes will be clearly identified.

Dispute resolution

July – August 2026

Where broad agreement cannot be achieved, FSO will engage with all relevant stakeholders to facilitate an outcome. Should a formal dispute be raised FSO will apply the Model Dispute Resolution Policy.
