

Inform and validate the future ICT Training Package architecture - participate in Sprint 2

Future Skills Organisation (FSO), in partnership with the Canberra Institute of Technology (CIT), invites you to participate in **Sprint 2 Consultation of the ICT Training Package Scoping**.

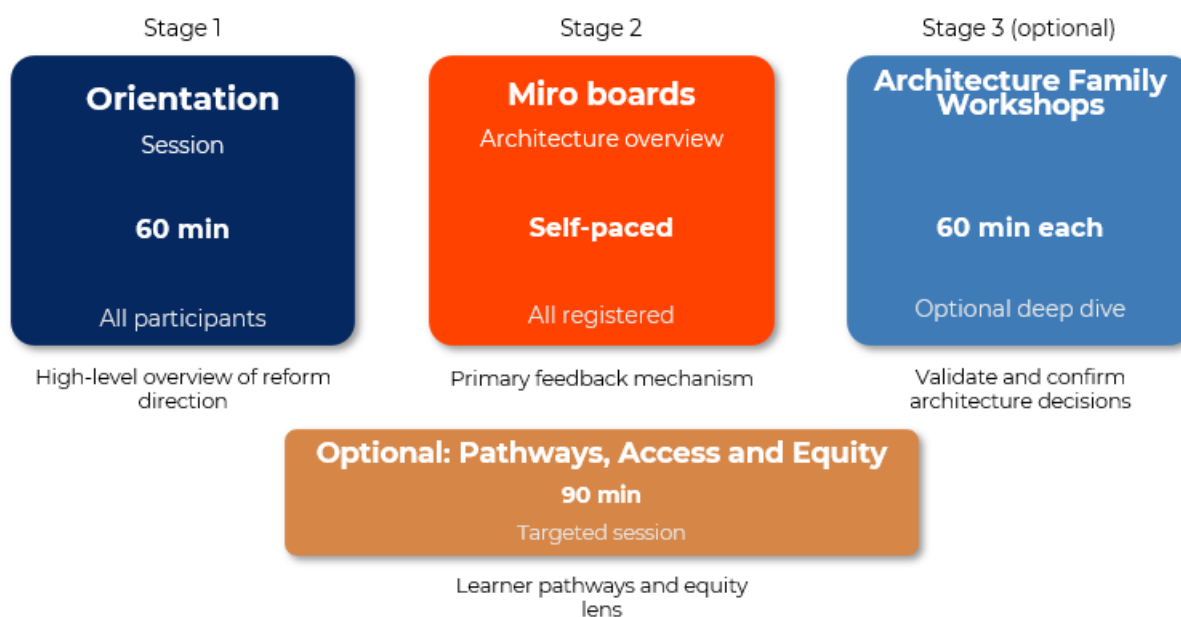
Sprint 2 is a structured validation phase. A draft architecture for ICT, Specialist Artificial Intelligence and Specialist Cyber Security has been developed that includes four architecture 'families' and now requires targeted validation before drafting begins.

This engagement replaces traditional consultation with a flexible, multi-step model, allowing participants to engage at the level most relevant to them.

HOW YOU CAN PARTICIPATE

You are invited to participate in one or more components of Sprint 2, depending on your interest, availability and expertise.

ICT Training Package Scoping – Sprint 2 Staged Engagement Process



1. Orientation Session (90 minutes)

This session is designed for stakeholders seeking a full-picture understanding before engaging further.

Provides a high-level overview of:

- The proposed ICT Training Package architecture

- The four-family model and reform direction
- Introduction and overview of the Miro boards
- Key design decisions and innovative ideas

2. Architecture Review via Interactive Miro Boards (Self-paced)

This is the primary mechanism for feedback collection, ensuring structured, traceable and auditable input.

All participants who register for the family sessions will have access to:

- Interactive Miro boards covering each specialist family
- Structured prompts to guide feedback
- You are invited to:
 - Review the draft architecture independently
 - Provide feedback directly within the boards

3. ICT Domain "Family" Validation Workshops (60 minutes each) — Optional deep dive

These are deep-dive sessions. Attendance is optional and intended for those wishing to engage in detailed validation.

A series of targeted workshops will be held across the four specialist families:

- Family 1: Platforms, Infrastructure and Networks
- Family 2: Cyber Security
- Family 3: Software, Data, AI and Web
- Family 4: IT Support and Service Management

These sessions will:

- Review and discuss feedback submitted via Miro
- Explore areas of alignment and divergence
- Confirm decision-ready positions on architecture design

4. Pathways, Access and Equity Session (60–90 minutes)

Stakeholders with insight into education pathways, learner access, or workforce participation are strongly encouraged to attend.

This targeted session will focus on system-level considerations, including:

- Learner pathways and progression across the system
- Articulation between secondary, VET and higher education
- Access and participation for priority cohorts
- Equity implications of qualification design
- Potential barriers or unintended consequences

WHAT THIS ENGAGEMENT IS (AND IS NOT)

This is:

- A validation process, not broad consultation
- Focused on testing whether the draft architecture is coherent, credible and fit-for-purpose

- Designed to produce evidence-based, decision-ready outcomes

This is not:

- A first exposure to content
- A general ideas forum
- A review of the current training package

Participants may choose the sessions most relevant to their role and interest.
